

Key Vocabulary for Lessons

Liturgical	Formal types of worship found in Roman Catholic and Anglican churches.
Non-liturgical	Informal types of worship.
Rosary	A string of beads with a crucifix attached.
Lords Prayer	A prayer Jesus taught his disciples.
Informal Prayer	Prayers that come directly from the person meeting their concerns.
Arrow Prayer	Short prayers addressed to God spontaneously at a time of urgent need.
Sacrament	A physical act that offers spiritual grace.
Baptism	Cleansing yourself from impurity.
Infant	A baby.
Eucharist	A sacrament remembering the Last Supper.
Last Supper	Jesus's final meal with his disciples before his crucifixion.
Divine Liturgy	What the Orthodox call the Eucharist.
Pilgrimage	A visit to a place regarded as holy.
Holy Land	This is Israel where Jesus was born.
Incarnation	A person who embodies a spirit or deity.
Immaculate conception	The idea that a person is born with original sin.
Holy week	The week leading up to Easter Sunday.
Maudy Money	Silver coins that represent the silver Judas expected as payment for betraying Jesus.
Street Pastors	Christians from local churches who take care of those on the street.
Evangelism	Spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ
Mission	A sending (of Christians)
Persecution	Hostility and ill-treatment of someone of a group.
Reconciliation	Bringing people together again.
LEDC's	Less economically developed countries.
Agency	A service offering help e.g. charity.
