Flank	To attack the enemy from the side

Banqueting House	The site where King Charles I was executed
Interregnum	The period of 11 years after Charles I's execution where there was no King of England
Protectorate	When England was ruled by Oliver Cromwell as Lord Protector
Levellers and Diggers	Two extreme political groups that wanted change after Charles' execution
The Rump Parliament	The Parliament that decided that Charles I should be executed
The Council of State	Oliver Cromwell's group of his closest advisors
Lord Protector	The title given to the person who ruled England during the Interregnum
The Restoration	When Charles II returned to England and brought back the English Monarchy
Procession	An official parade to celebrate an important event
Golden Age	A period of great happiness and achievement
The Royal Society	A group of scientists who carried out experiments
Revival	To bring something back
Dissenter	A person who goes against the beliefs of the Church
Samuel Pepys	A man who wrote a diary of the events of the Great Fire of London
Lord Mayor	A mayor of a major city
Fire Hooks	Hooks used to pull down a building to stop a fire spreading
Plague	A disease that spreads very easily
Miasma	The belief that disease is spread by "bad air"
Quarantine	When a sick person is isolated to stop other people catching the disease
