I am writing to inform you that following student and parental voice we are updating our school uniform policy regarding footwear. From 2 June 2025 students will be permitted to wear **plain black smart trainers** as part of their school uniform, instead of traditional school shoes.

To maintain a consistent and smart appearance, please ensure that footwear adheres to the following guidelines:

- Trainers must be entirely black, including soles and logos.
- No bright or contrasting colours, patterns, or branding should be visible.
- Footwear should be **smart in appearance** and suitable for a school environment.
